The store cattle that were nicely bred and showed potential sold 10 to 15 cents stronger than recent sales. The yearling steers – Hereford and Angus types weighing 320 to 360kgs made \$1060 to \$1150 per head. Yearling Angus heifers at 242kgs made \$810 per head. Poor types were difficult to sell. Bulls were disappointing.
