Prime Lambs - 1000

A small yarding of prime lambs met with solid demand. Medium types lifted by \$3 to \$5 per head.

Prime Ewes - 200

Smallest yarding of prime ewes for sometime. The market lifted by \$10 to \$15 per head. Lighter ewes saw the biggest gain.

Store Lambs - 2800

Several large lines of station bred lambs sold above expectations today. Lighter store lambs were more difficult to sell.
