The best prime beef steers sold up to \$3.35 per kg weighing in at 678kgs made \$2271 per head. Well finished steers improved 4 to 8 cents per kg.

Prime Hereford/Friesian cross heifers sold up to \$3.24 per kg at 502kgs made \$1626.50 per head, heifers were also up 5 to 10 cents per kg.
