### **Store Sheep - 600**

Mixed quality yarding of store sheep today. A line of well bred ewe lambs sold very well making up to \$169 per head. Ewes with lambs at foot had a very solid sale with better quality making \$129 to \$132 all counted.

### **Prime Cattle - 120**

Medium sized yarding of prime cattle today with all classes meeting good demand. The best steers made up to \$3.28 per kg, heifers up to \$3.18 per kg and cows \$2.10 per kg.

## **Store Cattle - 200**
