16-18mth Angus/Friesian cross steers at 360 – 400kgs made \$2.00 per kg.

16-18mth Hereford/Friesian cross heifers at 360 – 380kgs made \$2.03 per kg.

A tidy line of weaned beef calves from Putiki Farm sold from \$400 to \$690 per head.

Charolais cross steers at 195–285kgs made \$500 to \$650 per head (\$2.42 - \$2.60 per kg).

Charolais cross heifers at 187 – 260kgs made \$490 to \$650 per head (\$2.50- \$2.60 per kg).

Angus Steers at 201 – 252kgs made \$470 to \$670 per head (\$2.30 - \$2.65 per kg).
