A mixed quality yarding of prime hoggets eased slightly in line with some schedule deductions. Some tidy spring lambs sold well.

Good yarding of prime cattle with the market holding good values.

Some Angus/Charolais steers were the pick of the pens, they sold for \$3.47 per kg at 655kgs.

Not to be outdone the cow market flourished in the sun with Charolais cows at 671kgs making \$2.82 per kg.

Friesian cows made up to \$2.70 per kg.

Store Cattle - 612

A large store cattle yarding was met with good demand by locals and North Island influence.

R2 Steers made from \$1100 to \$1400 per head.

R2 Heifers made from \$700 to \$1040 per head.

A good line up of yearling cattle was on offer.

Straight beef was making \$3.30 per kg. Hereford/Friesian cross was mainly trading at \$2.90 to \$3.00 per kg.

Some cracking capital stock Hereford yearlings were offered due to a change in farming practice. They met strong spirited bidding, 20 at 374kgs made \$1315 per head (\$3.50 per kg).
