#### Prime Cattle

A Tuesday 'Cup Day' sale at Coalgate, saw the Prime Steers slide in value - 2 Belgian Blue Steers at 660kg peaked at \$3.26/kg. The best of the remaining was \$3.16 - \$3.20, for the 590 – 709kg range.

Beef Heifers peaked at \$3.20/kg for Angus & Angus/Hereford x. Most of the good Prime Heifers were \$3.05 - \$3.14/kg. 450 – 480kg weight ranged between \$2.80 - \$2.95/kg, and under 430kg were a difficult sale.

#### Store Cattle

Lees Valley Station sold 65 Yearling Angus & Angus/Hereford x Steers ranging from \$860 - \$1140/head.
