Prime Cattle

The Prime Cattle market was very strong. Most Steers ranged from \$2.88 - \$3.00/kg & Heifers made \$2.76 - \$2.99.

Two exceptional Limousin Steers at 570kg made \$3.18/kg, Hereford/Friesian x Steers at 600 – 645kg made \$2.95 - \$3.00 & 2 Shorthorn Steers at 550kg made \$2.96/kg.

Hereford/Friesian x Heifers at 553kg made \$2.96, Belted Galloway/Friesian x Heifers at 474kg made \$2.74/kg, Friesian Heifers at 531 – 587kg made \$2.30 - \$2.46/kg.

Store Cattle

The best of a small offering of Store Cattle were 15mth Hereford/Friesian x Steers at 371kg selling for \$1100 per head.

Weaner Calves had a strong sale. Hereford/Friesian x Bull Calves at 150kg made \$530 head, Speckle Park Heifer Calves at 110kg made \$500 head. Poorer type Beef x Calves sold for between \$350 - \$400 and Wagyu x Steers made \$320/head.
