# Prime & Store Cattle

It was a great day for the Prime Heifers, with the best of them making between \$3.10 - \$3.20/kg. The Prime Beef Steer market was also very strong, with a number of Steers making \$3.00/kg.

The Prime Cow market was also very strong; the best making \$2.30 - \$2.40/kg. The Prime Bull market was strong as well, with a large percentage making over \$2.90.

The Store market performed for the Cattle behind the gate today, especially the R2 Steers, the top pen from Fahey Farms making \$1860.

The trend continued with a very strong Calf market; the top pen of Steers making \$1070, and the Heifers \$805.
