Prime & Store Cattle

There was a large yarding of Prime Cattle at Coalgate today, with the majority of Prime Steers making over \$3.00/kg. The Prime Heifer market also held strong, with more than half the Heifers also reaching \$3.00/kg. There were good quality Cows, with the tops making \$2.28.

A large number of Store Cattle, predominately R2 Steers & Heifers were entered today. The top pen of Steers (Caledonian Farms) made \$1620, and the top Heifers (CE & AM Douglas) made \$1490. The Calf market was also promising with the top pen of Angus Steers (PJC & SM Smith) reaching \$890.
