### **Prime Cattle**

A large range of Prime Cattle was on offer from many different vendors. Steers sold from \$2.80 - \$3.05/kg, Heifers made \$2.40 - \$2.90/kg, and Cull Beef Cows \$1.70 - \$2.20/kg.

### **Store Cattle**

A large yarding of Store Cattle also, with many different vendors sending in their Calves & R2 Cattle. The Store market was firm with the amount of grass that is still around the country. R2 Steers made \$1100 - \$1280/head, R2 Heifers \$1100 - \$1330. Beef Heifer Calves made \$450 - \$600/head and the Steers made \$450 - \$620.
