The Prime market had a good lift from last week with Steers pushing up to \$3.22/kg, topping the day with a smart line of Angus Steers. Heifers were also strong with the top pen pushing up to \$3.21/kg. A good day for Cows & Bulls as well, with the best of the Cows making \$2.29/kg and the Bulls up to \$2.60/kg.

The Store Cattle had a smaller yarding with the best of the Heifers making \$1290 per head and the top pen of Calves selling for \$900 a head.
