Prime Cattle

Prime Steers eased slightly on last week. A pen of magnificent Angus Steers weighing 635kg sold for a sale topping \$3.12/kg or \$1981 per head. Hereford Steers made \$1925, 625kg at \$3.08/kg. Some quality Beef Heifers sold up to \$3.08 for Angus Heifers at 575kg. Other Charolais x types were \$2.90 - \$2.98/kg and the lighter end sold for \$2.80 - \$2.85/kg.

Store Cattle

2-year-old Cattle

Angus & Angus/Hereford x Steers from The Rock Partnership sold for \$1290 - \$1450 per head, \$3.12 - \$3.16/kg.

DC Gilberts' Hereford/Friesian x Steers made \$1340 - \$1400, \$3.10/kg.

Blairich Stations' Hereford Steers sold for \$1200 per head, \$3.13/kg. The Speckle Park Heifers made \$1100, \$3.00/kg and the Angus/Hereford x Heifers made \$1120 - \$1240, \$3.13/kg.

P & C Bond offered some Charolais/Friesian x Heifers that sold for \$1285 - \$1455, \$3.12 - \$3.15/kg.

Yearling Cattle

Blackford Farmings' Red Shed offered Speckle Park/Friesian x Steers at 322kg selling for \$1130, \$3.50/kg, Speckle Park/Friesian x Steers at 292kg selling for \$1050, \$3.59/kg, and Hereford/Friesian x Steers making \$1070, \$3.45/kg.

Speckle Park Steers from Blairich Station at 280kg made \$960, \$3.42/kg, Angus Heifers at 272kg sold for \$915, \$3.36/kg, Angus Heifers at 248kg sold for \$890, \$3.58/kg, and Angus/Hereford x Heifers at 265kg made \$910, \$3.43/kg.
