Prime Steers made \$2.98 - \$3.12. Some well finished Cattle saw a lift of 10 cents across the board.

Prime Heifers sold for \$2.85 - \$3.04.

Beef Cows made up to \$2.10, and Dairy Cows made \$1.70 - \$1.85.

A small yarding of mixed quality Yearling Stores made \$500 - \$800 per head with most weighing between 200 – 260kg.
