A medium size yarding of Prime Lambs held their values from previous weeks.

Mutton schedules easing have eventually taken their toll at the yards, with prices easing by approximately \$10 per head.

Store Lambs

A small yarding of Store Lambs/Hoggets & Hoggets with Lambs at foot.

Prime & Store Cattle

A large yarding of Cattle throughout. 155 Prime Steers sold between \$2.90 - \$3.16/kg, and 160 Prime Heifers made \$2.85 - \$3.10/kg.

70 Prime Cows made around \$2/kg.

The 20 Bulls were similar, making \$3/kg for a 600-800kg animal.

A solid sale.

The Store Cattle consisted of a nice line of Simmental Angus x Steers at 350kg, that made \$3.54/kg, and 287kg Hereford/Friesian x Steers which sold for \$3.41/kg. Store Heifers also sold well; 331kg Hereford Friesian x Heifers made \$3.23/kg. This reflected a short supply of quality Yearling Cattle.
