A sizable yarding of Stores of mixed quality. Good x bred Lambs saw spirited bidding. Lesser quality & finer woolled Lambs had limited interest but still sold slightly above previous weeks.

Prime & Store Cattle

The Prime Heifer market had more punch to it than the Steers. The highest price per kg were 9 Angus 16mth old Heifers weighing 459kg, which sold for \$2.92/kg or \$1340 per head. Heavy Hereford Friesian x Heifers weighing 580-662kg made \$2.84-\$2.88/kg. Lighter Hereford Friesian x & Murray Grey Friesian x Heifers weighing 445-465kg made

\$2.71-\$2.80/kg. Prime Steers peaked at \$2.90/kg. Randal Inch's Charolais x Steers weighing 645kg sold for

\$2.90/kg or \$1870.50 a head. All other well-finished Steers made \$2.82-\$2.86/kg, with the lighter Steers 442–460kg making \$2.78-\$2.84/kg.

Friesian Cows at 513kg made \$1.83/kg, and at 627kg made \$1.85/kg.

Murray Grey Bulls at 633kg made \$2.93, and Angus Bulls at 506kg made \$2.85. Sire Bulls weighing 850-1100kg sold for \$1.90-\$1.96/kg.

A small yarding of Store Cattle with a variety of quality. The best Angus 16mth Steers weighing 465kg made \$1450 per head. Off-type Beef Steers at 390kg made \$1100 a head. Charolais x Heifers at 382kg made \$1070 per head & some Plum Angus Heifers at 406kg made \$1200 a head.
