Prime & Store Cattle

A small but quality line up of heavy Prime Cattle today with Steers mostly weighing 600kg + making \$2.80 - \$3.00/kg, and the Heifers \$2.80 - \$2.90/kg.

A small yarding in the Store Pens, mostly calves were yarded. R2 Steers weighing 415kg – 459kg made \$1100 - \$1240, and the Calves ranged from \$400 - \$550 for the top pen of Angus Calves.
