Prime Lambs

A moderate sized yarding of Prime Lambs saw the market firm for the lighter weights, with a slight easing at the heavy end.

Prime Ewes

There was around 480 Ewes here today at Coalgate with some good quality present. The market was firm on last week with most of the Ewes trading in between the \$60 - \$80 mark.

Store Lambs

Just 4000 Store Lambs yarded today saw good competition for shorn & sexed Cross Bred Lambs. Smaller, long-term Lambs are harder to place. A line of Half-Bred Lambs sold, but seemed like good farming with the per kg price below \$2.00.

Several lines of Breeding Ewes sold for just above prime value.

Prime & Store Cattle

A smaller yarding of Prime Cattle this week. A nice line up of Murray Grey Steers started the offering, topping at \$2.76. A 670kg Simmental Steer topped all pens at \$2.80. \$2.74 was achieved for a pen of Exotic x Heifers at 488kg.

A good yarding of Bulls topped at \$2.88, down to \$2.18 on lighter Jersey Bulls.

A small but quality yarding of Stores today, mostly made up of a line of 18mth Angus Heifers, they made from \$870 - \$1105 per head.
