

Coalgate Sale Yards 5 March 2024

Autumn Beef Sale

A quality yarding of 1150 straight Beef Cattle met with good demand.

Angus & Angus Hereford x Steers from PFW Boag in Motunau had 202 Angus Steers which made \$1055 - \$1320 per head, \$3.12 – \$3.19 kg & 140 Angus Hereford x Steers that made \$1150 - \$1400 per head, \$3.04 - \$3.26 kg.

Duncan & Kate Calder from Grasmere Station had 49 Angus Steers making \$1210 - \$1460 per head, \$3.12 - \$3.14 kg.

Quartz Hill Station, Rakaia Gorge had 111 Angus Steers making \$1060 – \$1500 head, topping the sale, \$3.13 - \$3.20 kg.

Lower Farm, Hanmer Springs had 60 Angus & Angus Hereford x Steers at \$1220 - \$1310 head, \$3.08 - \$3.11 kg.

Quartz Hill Station also yarded 34 Simmental x Steers making \$1200 - \$1360, and the 34 Heifers made \$1100 - \$1325, or \$3.04 - \$3.11 kg.

Stu Smith, Fernside had 50 Charolais Heifers making \$1210 - \$1290, \$2.91 kg.

Huttview, Methven sold 60 Simmental Heifers making \$1350 - \$1450, \$3.00 - \$3.16kg.
