## Prime & Store Cattle

A significant lift in all sections of the Prime Sale today at Coalgate. Angus Steers peaked at \$3.97 – 575kg. Most Steers were \$3.84 - \$3.90 with unfinished, lean types making \$3.70. 678kg Hereford Friesian x Steers made \$3.90, 575kg Angus & Angus Hereford x Steers made \$3.97, 570kg Angus Hereford x & Angus Simmental x Steers made \$3.92. Heifers were even more sought after than Steers, several pens made \$3.94 - \$3.99kg. TM Inch Ltd (Loburn) 2 573kg Angus Hereford x Heifers made \$3.99, McDonald Downs (Hawarden) 3 540kg Hereford Heifers made \$3.94, McDonald Downs (Hawarden) 5 499kg Angus & Angus Hereford x Heifers made \$3.99, DM & AD Smith, 13 552kg Angus Friesian x Heifers made \$3.92. Prime Bulls sold from \$3.94 - \$4.10, 530 – 590kgs. Beef Cows sold from \$2.60 - \$2.70 & Dairy Cows made from \$2.40 - \$2.44.

In the Store Cattle, 18mth Angus Steers sold particularly well, 400 – 440kgs were trading at \$4.00 - \$4.22kg with the advertised line of Angus Steers from Lower Farm making between \$1410 - \$1760.
