A bigger yarding of better-quality Store Lambs were met with very strong demand. The market was up \$10 per head, especially for lighter Lambs. Once again, high demand matched by a medium level of supply.

### **Prime & Store Cattle**

The prices in the Prime market reflected demand again today, with Prime Steers making up to \$5.08, & Heifers making up to \$5.14. The Prime Cows reached \$3.72, with the Prime Bulls making up to \$5.26 in what was a very competitive sale.

The Store Market was competitive as well, with some quality Cattle yarded.

The R2 Steers made \$2310, R2 Heifers made \$2200, and Dairy Beef calves sold for \$770 alongside some Friesian Bull Calves at \$750.
