Prime Steers were at a similar level to last week, & peaked at \$4.84, however we saw a \$0.05 – 0.20c, in the Prime Heifers this week, peaking at \$4.78. A smaller yarding of Prime Cows sold to similar levels as last week, and we had a lower quality yarding of Bulls which the prices reflected.

The two-year-old Store Cattle had a very solid sale with a definite lift on last week. A mixed yarding of R1 Cattle saw the quality Cattle sell well.
