A quality yarding of Cattle in today. The market held steady through the sale. Prime Steers made from \$4.90 - \$5.34. Prime Heifers made \$4.70 - \$5.23. Prime Beef Cows made \$4.20 - \$4.62 and Friesian Cows made \$4.00 - \$4.38. There was a nice line up of Bulls today with a 560kg Highland Bull making \$5.35.

In the Stores there was a nice yarding. Northern Graziers had some nice R2 Angus Steers that made \$2230, and the Bullockburn R2 Angus Steers made \$2150.
